Undocumented residents in the Bay Area have very limited access to specialty care because they are not covered by the Affordable Care Act.

Community clinics rely on our services for their patients who need specialty procedures. We will provide over 1600 services this year.

Our Network

Over 1,000 surgical professionals and interpreters volunteer at 47 partner hospitals & surgery centers in 9 Bay Area counties.
