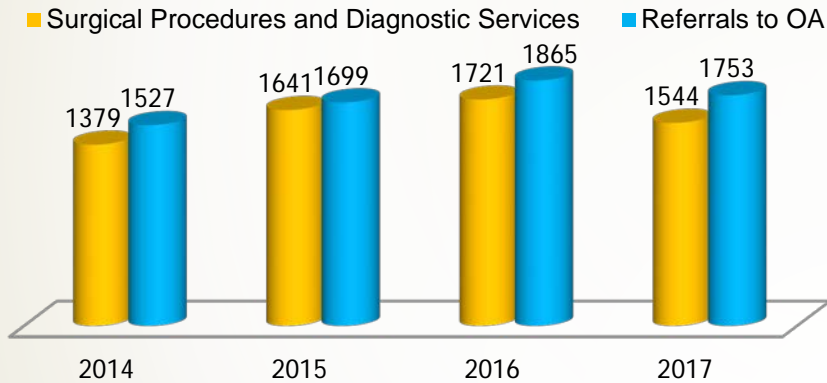


Operation Access enables Bay Area health care providers to donate vital surgical and specialty care to people in need. We envision health care equity for people facing barriers to care.

Bay Area Statistics



Since 1993, Operation Access has provided care coordination, patient navigation, and volunteer engagement to coordinate over 18,000 donated surgical procedures and diagnostic services for over 12,500 low-income, uninsured Bay Area residents.

There is a high need for specialty care services among those still uninsured despite the Affordable Care Act, including undocumented immigrants.

Outpatient Services Provided

Breast, Dermatology, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Gynecology, Plastic and Reconstructive, Ophthalmology, Oral Surgery (pilot), Orthopedics, Otolaryngology, Urology, Vascular
Other outpatient services may be available.

Over \$15 million in Charity Care was provided in 2017

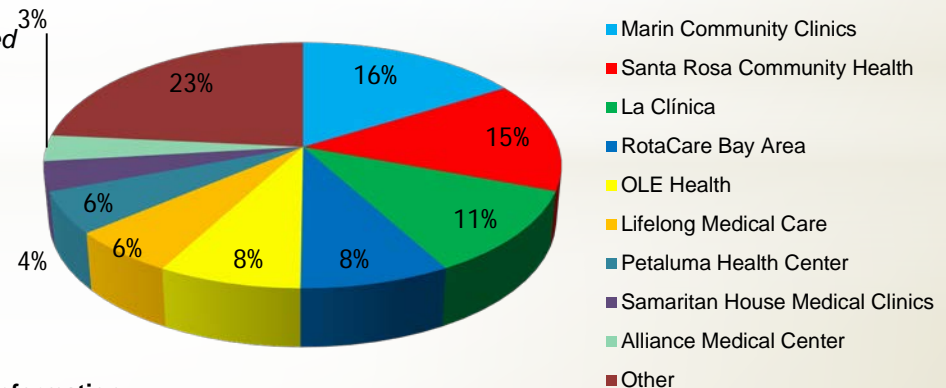
