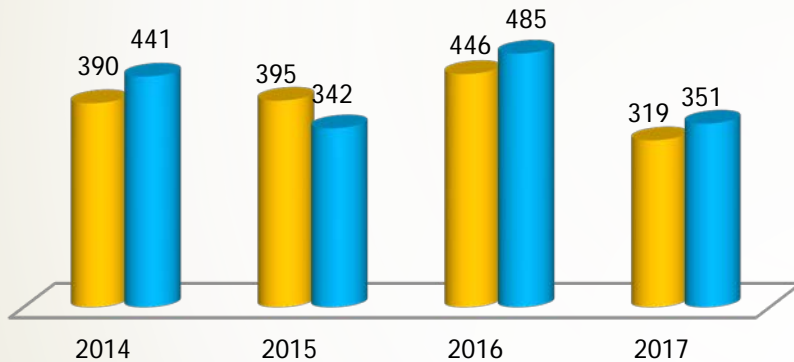


Operation Access enables Bay Area health care providers to donate vital surgical and specialty care to people in need. We envision health care equity for people facing barriers to care.

Since 2002, Operation Access has provided care coordination, patient navigation, and volunteer engagement to coordinate over 3,800 surgical procedures and diagnostic services for low-income, uninsured Contra Costa residents.

There is a high need for services among those still uninsured despite the Affordable Care Act, including undocumented immigrants.

Outpatient Services Provided

Breast, Dermatology, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Gynecology, Plastic and Reconstructive, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Otolaryngology, Urology, Vascular

Other outpatient services may be available.

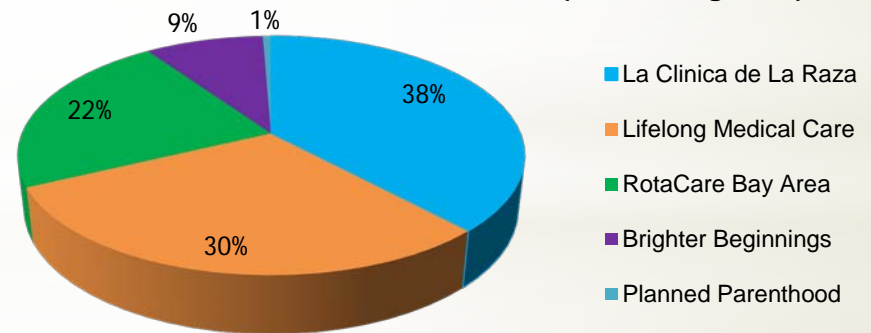
