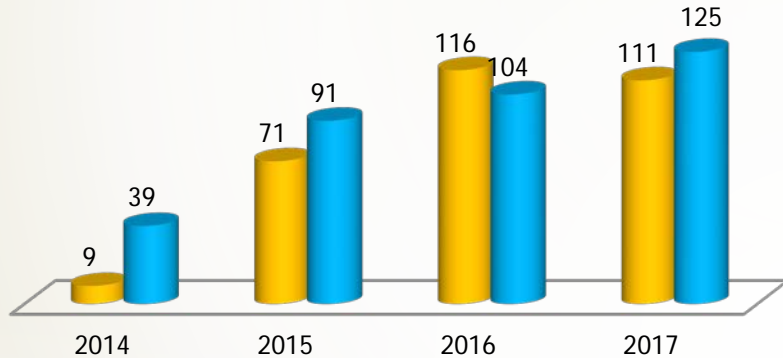


Operation Access enables Bay Area health care providers to donate vital surgical and specialty care to people in need. We envision health care equity for people facing barriers to care.

The Operation Access program in Napa launched with its first referrals received in August of 2014. There is a high need for services among those still uninsured despite the Affordable Care Act, including undocumented immigrants.

*Other outpatient services may be available.*

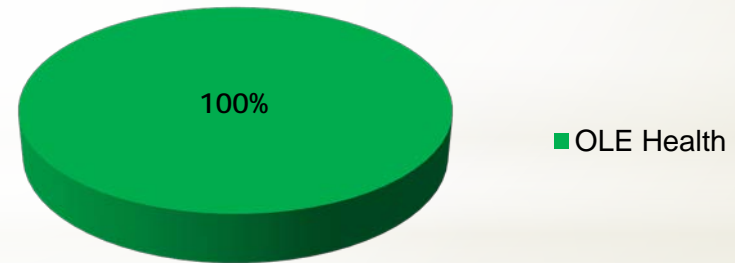
