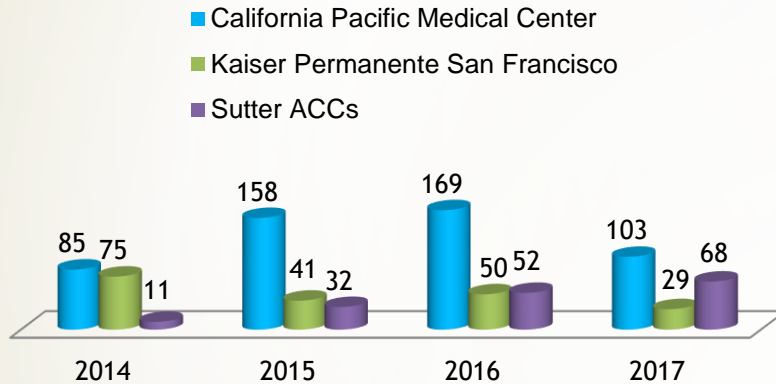


Operation Access enables Bay Area health care providers to donate vital surgical and specialty care to people in need. We envision health care equity for people facing barriers to care.

Services Provided in San Francisco



Since 1993, Operation Access has provided care coordination, patient navigation, and volunteer engagement to coordinate over 3,200 vital outpatient surgical procedures and diagnostic services in San Francisco.

There is a high need for services among those still uninsured in the nine county Bay Area, despite the Affordable Care Act, including undocumented immigrants.

Outpatient Services Provided

Breast, Dermatology, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Gynecology, Plastic and Reconstructive, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Otolaryngology, Urology, Vascular

Other outpatient services may be available.

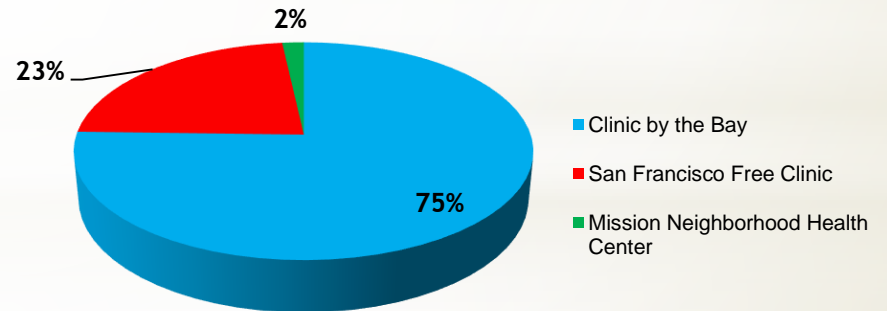
