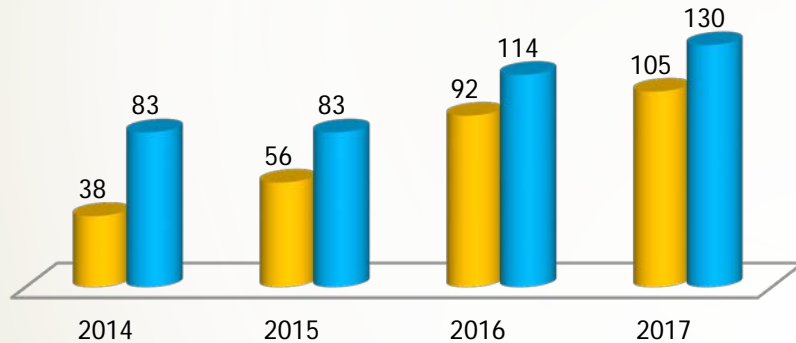

■ Surgical Procedures and Diagnostic Services ■ Referrals to OA



Since 2005, Operation Access has provided care coordination, patient navigation, and volunteer engagement to coordinate over 300 surgical procedures and diagnostic services to low-income, uninsured Solano County residents.

In 2016, community clinics identified a need for over 200 specialty services per year that is not being addressed by other programs. OA is working to meet this need in collaboration with other community partners.

### Outpatient Services Provided

Breast, Dermatology, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, Gynecology, Plastic and Reconstructive, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Otolaryngology, Urology, Vascular

### Participating Hospitals and Ambulatory Care Centers

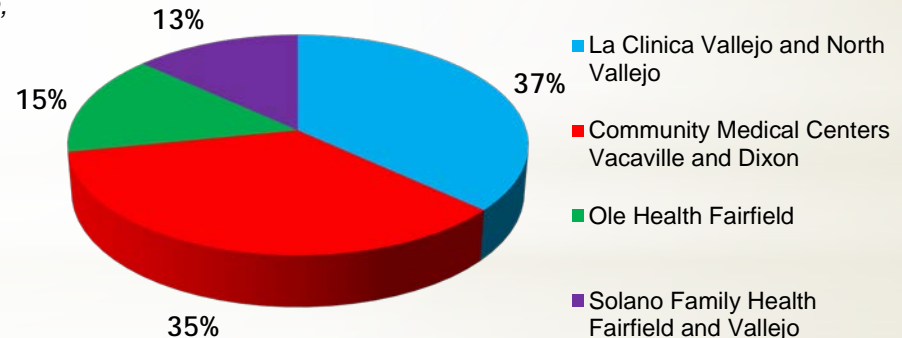
